

What to Expect As Trinity Resumes Indoor Worship

Changes to Worship:

- A. Singing will be limited to our music leaders. We regret that all of us cannot participate in this meaningful part of worship. We will be back to singing together as soon as we can do it in a way that we know is safe.
- B. No offering plate will be passed, though we will have a container for offerings in the narthex area.
- C. We will remain in our places for the passing of peace.
- D. Individual communion packages will be waiting for you as you take your seat. We will share in the consecration of those elements together, but we will wait until we are back outside to actually eat the bread and drink the wine/juice. This will prevent us from needing to remove our masks while inside.

Other Safety Information

1. If anyone has tested positive for COVID-19 and attended a TLC function in the last 14 days, please call or email the church office so we can anonymously inform the congregation and work with the health officials in King County.
2. When indoor gatherings begin, please self screen before to coming to church. If you are feeling sick for any reason, have a temperature of 100.4F or more, or see that your children do not feel well, please do not come to church. If you have been in contact with someone within the last 14 days who has tested positive for COVID-19, please do not come to church. Please do contact the church, however, because we would like to pray for you!

3. Please maintain at least 6 feet between you and anyone outside your immediate household. The pews will be marked with places to sit that are generously separated. Our volunteers will guide you to your seats.
4. State guidelines ask us to use only one entrance so that we can more easily monitor who is coming and going. Our only entrance with a ramp is the Northwest door that faces the back parking lot – the one that enters beside the main bathrooms. Please plan to use this door to enter. Other doors might be open for ventilation, but we will have signs directing you to enter through the Northwest door.
5. We will sanitize our sanctuary, our narthex area, our bathrooms, and all commonly touched surfaces in these areas before and after each indoor Sunday worship service. We will also ensure that hand soap and sanitizer are readily available, and that our sinks are in good working order for washing hands.
6. Bathroom doors should be propped open whenever the room is not in use to provide better ventilation. No more than 2 people should be in any bathroom at one time.
7. Everyone older than 2 must wear a mask throughout gatherings. Please have your mask on before you exit your car. We will have extra masks available for anyone who forgets to bring one.
8. Tissues and trash cans will be readily available. If you need to sneeze or cough, please try to use a tissue and immediately throw it away. Then please wash hands.
9. We cannot safely serve food or coffee at this time. Sorry!
10. We will use a system of fans to keep air consistently circulating in and out from the outdoors. The sanctuary might be colder than normal because of this. Please dress accordingly.
